No one can heal my disease except He Who knows the depths of the heart.

How many times have I set boundaries for myself and build walls between myself and sin! But my thoughts transgressed the boundaries and my will tore down the walls, for

the boundaries were not secured by the fear of God, and the walls were not founded on sincere repentance.

And again I knock at the door, that it may open for me. I do not cease to ask that I may receive what I request; and I know no shame in seeking Thy mercy, O Lord.

O Lord, my Savior! Why has Thou forsaken me. Have mercy on me, O only Lover of mankind. Save me, a sinner, Thou only Sinless one.
